The gross for the sale was \$5,050. The bulbs cost \$1,612 giving us a profit of \$3,438 to benefit the Scholarship Fund! The bulbs will be available for pick up in September. Those of you who ordered bulbs will receive notification as soon as the bulbs arrive.
