

From the Beginning . . .

The Fairfield Glade Garden Club was formed to encourage interest

Who Is Eligible - Category 1 or Category 2

Category 2: The student must pursue an agricultural/horticultural associate degree or other training certificate pertaining to the food web.


Selection Process uses the following criteria:

- 3) Extracurricular Activities & References
- 4) Personal Interview
- 5) Letter of Introduction

Scholarship Awards

Scholarship amounts vary from year to year, dependent on the number of recipients and funds raised. **Students are eligible for additional financial assistance for subsequent school years provided they re-apply and continue in an appropriate field of study.**

Fairfield Glade Garden Club works with the Cumberland County High School Horticulture Program by holding annual plant sales of geraniums and ferns in late Spring and poinsettias in early December. The proceeds of these sales are contributed to The Helena Schmidt Scholarship Fund.
