The Monkey Orchid

The monkey orchid, also known as Dracula Simia, is native to the cloud forests of Central and South America, particularly in Ecuador, Peru, and Colombia:

Monkey orchids thrive in cool, moist, humid conditions at high altitudes. They are epiphytic, meaning they grow in the crotches of trees, or terrestrial, meaning they grow in humus-rich soils on forest floors.

The flowers smell like ripe oranges.
