I was asked by several people for the recipe for the Lemon Pineapple Cake that I brought to the August meeting. So here it is. Enjoy!

### *Lemon Pineapple Cake*

1 box of Jiffy yellow cake mix. Make as directed and bake in a 13x9 pan. Let cool.

1 large can crushed pineapple, drained

1 8 ounce cream cheese, softened. Slowly mix with 2 cups of milk. Then slowly add 1 package of lemon instant pudding. Mix well. Refrigerate for 5 minutes.

Spread pudding mixture on cake, then layer crushed pineapple, then Cool Whip (8 ounces).

Sprinkle with chopped walnuts.

Refrigerate for 12 hours.
